The wedding is planned for May 9, 2009, in Columbia.

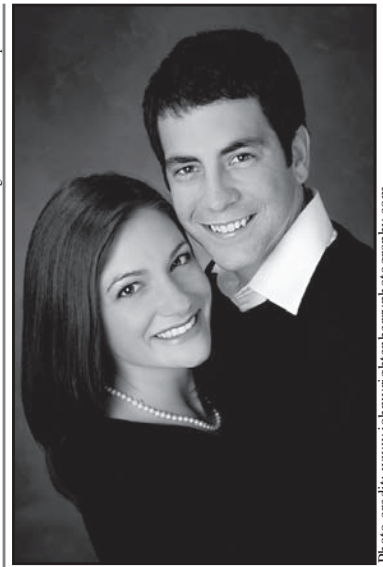
