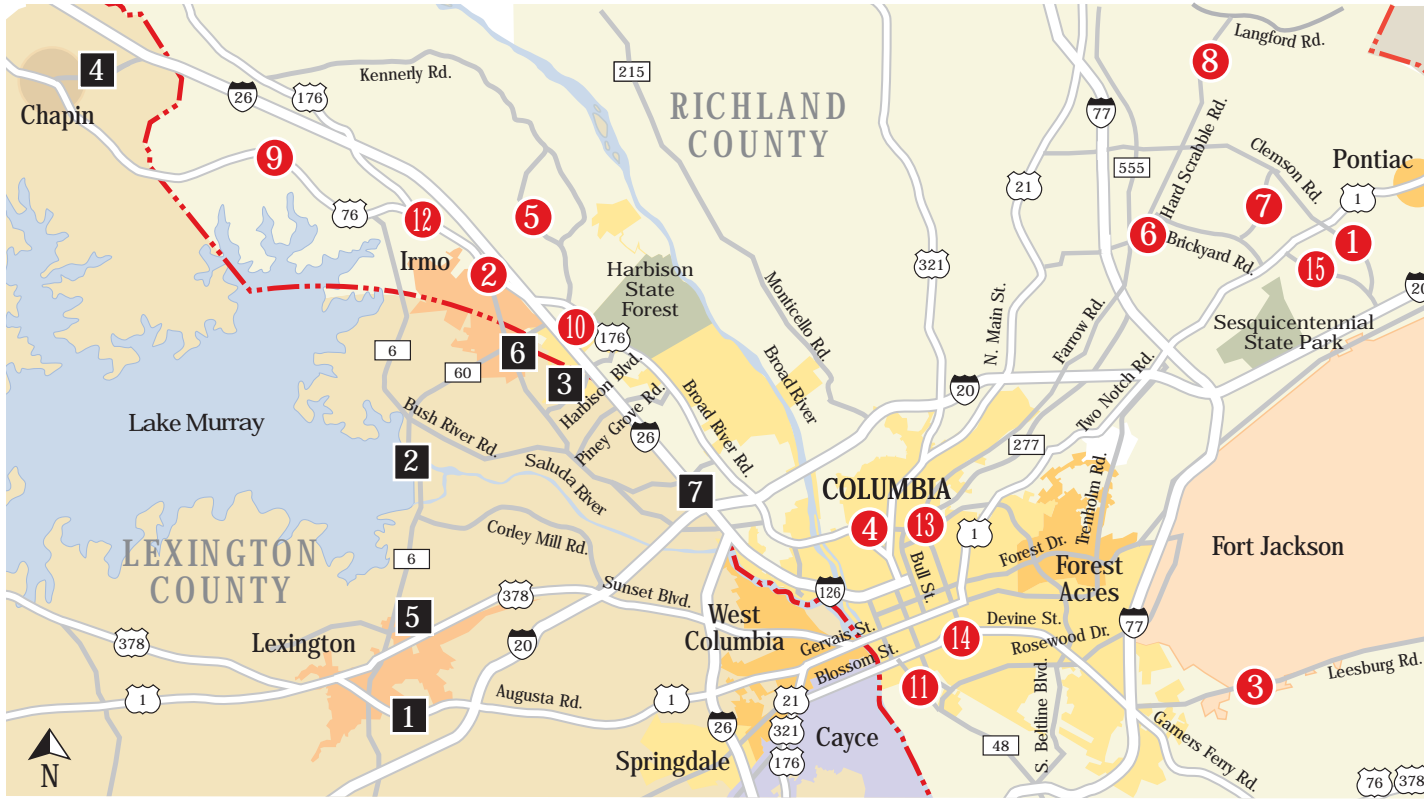


CLOGGED ROADS

- 5** Kennerly Road from Coogler Road to U.S. 176
- 6** Hard Scrabble Road from Sloan Road to Farrow Road
- 7** North Springs Road from N. Brickyard Road to Clemson Road
- 8** Hard Scrabble Road from Langford Road to Sloan Road
- 9** U.S. 76 from Lexington County line to S.C. 6
- 10** Kinley Road from Lake Murray Boulevard to Broad River Road
- 11** Bluff Road from Ohio Street to S.C. 48
- 12** U.S. 176 from S.C. 6 to N. Woodrow Street
- 13** Marshall Street from Farrow Road to Sunset Drive
- 14** Blossom Street from Saluda Avenue to Hilton Street
- 15** Sparkleberry Lane from Ribson Way to Clemson Road
